General Math Hub Rules

- Always bring your FDTC photo ID with you to the Hub. It is needed to check in/out of the facility.
- Use of a student ID or student ID # that is not yours will result in an academic misconduct violation.
- Children are not allowed in the Math Hub areas.
- Please be quiet while in the Math Hub areas.
- No programs allowed on calculators for MAT 033-102.
- Absolutely no food, drinks, socializing, cell phones, or profanity in the Math Hub at any time.

Testing Policies

- **No test will be started after one hour prior to the scheduled Hub closing time.**
- Bring your FDTC photo ID card. Students without an FDTC ID will be allowed to test in the Math Hub with an alternate PHOTO ID when verified by a Math Hub Staff member. Students may also be verified by an FDTC instructor supplying the student's FDTC ID number.
- Bring your own calculator. *MAT 101/102 students will be required to use the gold FDTC graphing calculator supplied by the Hub for testing. Students may also use the virtual calculators provided on the workstations.
- Please ONLY bring your FDTC ID, calculator, and pen/pencil to testing. All personal items (including purses, cell phones and smart watches) will be required to be locked in a locker in room 7106.
- When testing, students are NOT allowed to click on any other websites or open any other computer files/programs. Such acts will be considered "cheating" and the test will be submitted immediately.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the computer once their test is started. If a student leaves the computer with a test open, the test will be submitted immediately by Hub staff.
- The student should not submit their own test upon completion. The student should raise the "HELP" flag allowing a Math Hub Staff member to submit and record the grade.
- Only the provided Math Hub colored scratch paper will be allowed for tests.
- The provided scratch paper will be turned in when the Math Hub Staff member submits the test.
